Tennis Court/Pickleball Court Option

- David Kuniholm did some research on the cost to repair the Tennis Courts
- Option one presented was taking apart the current pickleball court and add lines at the price of 18,060 through Arlington Pavement.
- Option two presented and the cheapest is putting Versacourt down on the existing courts
- Option three presented is to have a paving company redo the court itself, and the quotes he received was \$40,550 from Springfield Paving and \$27,000 from Arlington Paving. The next step is hiring out an additional Tennis company to finish up the work.
